## A high-quality, ethical carbon offsetting scheme

SCIF helps organisations achieve their climate goals through **transparent, verified, evidence-based, and community-focused offset projects**, which **benefit people and planet**. Unlike other offsetting schemes, every pound invested goes directly into projects that reduce and capture carbon emissions, restore ecosystems, improve health and wellbeing and provide socio-economic opportunities for communities affected by climate change. SCIF projects are co-created with local partners and communities.

## Why offsets matter

Offsets complement your emissions reductions to help achieve **net-zero targets**. Many organisations face challenges with low-quality credits or greenwashing risks. Our model ensures that every contribution delivers **real, measurable impact**, as verified by Gold Standard.

## Our approach

- **Verified and transparent:** All projects are independently audited and tracked for measurable results. We use Gold Standard methodology.
- **Health, environment and socio-economic co-benefits:** SCIF projects contribute to better health and wellbeing in communities, creating new socio-economic opportunities, especially for women and girls. Our work in schools ensures children stay healthy and can dedicate their time to learning.
- **Data collection, research and best practice:** measuring the impact of our projects is an essential part of SCIF operations. Data collection helps inform our research and evidence base and lead to effective advocacy to influence policy.

Our projects are predominantly located in LMICs where climate resilience projects are most needed, including:

- High-impact community-based projects: Safe Water projects delivering clean water to communities, especially children and women.
- Soil nutrients regeneration and carbon sequestration
- Peatland restoration and protection
- Plastic waste removal and reprocessing
